ENTRY: Entries are open to all NRA members in good standing, (NRA member application information will be available at the tournament). Entries will be limited to 23 competitors in one relay. Advance entries to Tom Suswal at tsuswal@bellsouth.net are appreciated. Entries & fees will be accepted day of the events up to the range capacity. Shooters who wish to shoot only parts of the 2700 are welcome and encouraged to do so. But preference will be given to shooters entered into the complete 2700 match. Event Protocol: The .22 caliber match will start at 10 AM. The .22 and Center fire portions will be shot before the lunch break and the .45 caliber match after lunch. All events are fired outdoors at 50 and 25 yards on paper targets. Competitors will go downrange to score, repair, and patch targets after each 10 record shot series. Competitors are encouraged to bring a small clipboard, pencils, calculator, stapler, and staples. Awards will be given based on NRA Classification system. Current NRA Pistol Rules will govern the tournaments. You are encouraged to obtain a current copy of the NRA Pistol Rules from the NRA.

IMPORTANT NOTE: RBGC's Chief Range Officer feels in order to enhance and ensure range safety **Empty Chamber Indicators** or **Clear Barrel Indicators** will be required for all competitors. A simple device such as orange weed eater cord or a yellow, red, or orange commercial device will suffice.

Weather: All Tournaments will be held rain or shine. River Bend's firing line is covered and affords good protections from the elements. But you should not forget your rain gear or sun block. The weather in the summer can be hot, please bring water and take care to protect your self from the heat.

Lunch and Camping: Please note you should bring your own lunch and drinks to the match we do not have food service at RBGC. Camping is allowed at RBGC and we have electrical but no water or sewer hook-ups. Please call in advance if you plan to camp at the range.

Additional Practice Match: As in the past an E.I.C. Leg / NRA D.R Match will be offered at the end of the day. For those who wish to shoot this event it will be the 30 shot National Match Course but it will not count towards the completion of any portion of the E.I.C. or NRA D.R program. **This will be a practice match only.** Cost will be \$1.00 and all fees will be returned to the match winners of each event.
