TOURNAMENT RULES: CURRENT NRA PISTOL RULES WILL GOVERN.

ELIGIBILITY: NRA Membership is not required-general regulation A-11.

ENTRY FEE: Individual entry is \$10.00 per 900 aggregate. Package entry is \$27.00, for the 2700 aggregate match including the NRA match registration fee.

MATCH BULLETIN: A copy of the official match bulletin will be given to each competitor upon completion of the 2700 aggregate match.

ENTRIES: Limited to 36 competitors. Entries close at the beginning of the three minute preparation period for the .45 cal match, squatting is not required. Advanced entries are encouraged.

FIRING STARTS: Firing starts at 0930 hours.

CLASSIFICATION: NRA rule 19 inclusive. Competitors are responsible for their classification.

SCORING: All strings of fire will be scored after 10 shots. Competitors will score, repair, and replace targets. Competitors may use overlays to determine shot value. Plugs will be used by match officials only.

TARGETS: All firing will be conducted upon NRA Official Targets. The B-6 and B-6(C) targets will be used at 50 yards and the B-8 and B-8(C) at 25 yards.

MATCH SCHEDULE: Match #1 .22 Cal slow fire, 20 shots, 50 yards.
Match #2 .22 Cal National Match Course, 30 shots.
Match #3 .22 Cal timed fire, 20 shots, 25 yards.
Match #4 .22 Cal rapid fire, 20 shots, 25 yards.
Match #5 .22 Cal aggregate of matches 1, 2, 3, and 4.
Match #6 Center fire, slow fire, 20 shots, 50 yards.
Match #7 Center fire, National Match Course, 30 Shots.
Match #8 Center fire, timed fire, 20 shots, 25 yards.
Match #9 Center fire, rapid fire, 20 shots, 25 yards.
Match #10 Center fire, aggregate of Matches 6, 7, 8, and 9.
Match #11 .45 Cal slow fire, 20 shots, 50 yards.
Match #12 .45 Cal National Match Course, 30 shots.
Match #13 .45 Cal timed fire, 20 shots, 25 yards.
Match #14 .45 Cal rapid fire, 20 shots, 25 yards.
Match #15 .45 Cal aggregate of matches 11, 12, 13, and 14.
Match #16 Grand aggregate of Matches 5, 10, and 15.

AWARD SCHEDULE: Open winner in each individual match and in each aggregate will be awarded to the competitor with the highest score. First place awards will be awarded to competitors in each class having three or more shooters. Six or more shooters provide a second place and nine or more a third place. Unclassified competitors will shoot in a new shooter class providing there are three or more shooters and, if not, they shall compete in the master class. Any class that does not consist of three or more shooters, the competitor will compete in the next higher class. All awards will be made with the NRA award coupons. The number of competitors participating in the tournament will determine award schedule. Awards will be given out prior to the competitor departure from the range.

GENERAL INFORMATION: Directions to the range - From I-26, take exit 115 south (321) to the first traffic light, turn right on to Fish Hatchery Road, go to stop sign (5 miles), turn right, go around a curve and continue straight (0.8 mile), there is a range gate and a B-6 Pistol Target attached to a post on the left. Food – Please brown bag your own lunch. Alcohol - No alcoholic beverage is allowed on the range. Note - The sponsor reserves the right to alter the match schedule in accordance with the weather and range conditions.
