Sponsor: Norfolk County Rifle Range, Inc.

Location: 4321 S Military Highway, Chesapeake, VA 23321 between Exit 14 from I-664 South and Rotunda Ave.

Rules: Current NRA Pistol Rules will govern these matches.

Eligibility: Entries are open to a maximum of 18 competitors.

Entry Fees: Three guns - \$20 (includes \$4.50 NRA registration fee); Two guns - \$15 (includes \$4.50 NRA registration fee); One gun - \$10 (includes \$4.50 NRA registration fee). Fees may be paid with check, cash or NRA Award Points.

Entries Close: At the time of competition.

Classification: NRA classifications will be used. In the event two or less Masters and High Masters compete, they will only be eligible for the open awards. Three or more competitors are required to make a class, otherwise they will compete in the next higher class. An unclassified shooter will compete in the Master class. If there are two or more unclassified shooters they will form an Unclassified class and they will compete for awards in that class as well as open awards.

Relay Times: Firing will start promptly at 6:30 pm for the first (Friday) relay. The second relay will begin at 8:30 am on Saturday.

Entries are limited to 9 persons per relay.

Challenges: A fee of \$1.00 will be charged for each challenge made. Challenges may be made up to one hour after the scores to be challenged are posted.

Awards: 75% of the entry fees (excluding the NRA registration fees) will be returned as awards. Awards will be given for open winners and for each class winner. Second place awards will be given in classes with five or more competitors and third place awards will be given in classes with nine or more competitors. Awards will be in the form of NRA award points and/or cash.

General Info: Everyone on the range must use eye and ear protection while firing is in progress. The facility is a 25 yard indoor range with turning targets. There is a clubroom with bathrooms for men and women and water, sodas and snacks are available for purchase. A Subway sandwich shop and motel are nearby.
