Rules: NRA rules will govern the match.  
NRA membership is not required but recommended.

Schedule: Friday- 2700 short course match (25 yds). A registered match separate  
from the Regional.

Saturday- .22,CF and Distinguished Revolver. Team matches after DR;  
(.22,CF). Team matches will be fired.

Sunday- .45 and CMP-EIC match. Team .45 match will follow EIC  
Match. Team match will be fired.

Weather: Matches will be fired rain or shine. We do have a covered firing line.

Match Fees: Friday 2700 short course \$35  
Regional 2700 \$60  
Distinguished Revolver \$10  
CMP\_EIC \$15

Anyone wanting to shoot a 900 may do so: \$15 per 900 for Friday and  
\$25 per 900 on Saturday or Sunday. Preference will be given to shooters  
that want to shoot the full match.

The Regional Match will have 50 firing points available if necessary; 2 relays of 25.

The Short Course will have 25 firing points available; 1 relay of 25.

Entries will be honored in the order they were received and will be accepted until full or until 15 minutes before the match starts.

Course of fire:

Individual Matches- .22, CF, .45 will consist of:

20 shot slow fire match  
30 shot National Match Course  
20 shot timed fire match  
20 shot rapid fire match

The sum of the 90 shots will be the 900 aggregate score.

Grand Aggregate will be the sum of the 3 individual matches (.22,CF,.45).

The NRA Distinguished Revolver and the CMP- Excellence In Competition matches will be 30 shot National Match Courses.

Cash Awards will be determined by the number of participants in each Class. There must be 3 or more shooters to make a class or that class will Be grouped with the next higher class up to Master. NRA classifications will be used. A unclassified shooter will shoot in the master class. Awards will stay in classes (high masters vs high masters, masters vs masters, etc.)

Distinguished Revolver: no cash award

CMP-EIC: no cash award

Categories:     There will be no categories other than skill level.

Challenges: A challenge fee of \$2 will be charged for each challenge made. If the challenge is upheld the fee will be returned. Statistical challenges must be made no later than 1 hour after each 900 aggregate and grand aggregate are posted.

General: Complete 900 aggregate will be shot before changing relays. Competitors will score targets as directed by range officer. Use of plug gauges will be restricted to range officers only. Empty chamber indicators will be used per NRA rules.

RIVER BEND GUN CLUB EIC MATCH  
MARCH 28, 2010

An Excellence In Competition match will be held in conjunction with a NRA Regional match on March 28, 2010 at River Bend Gun Club. It will be held in accordance with the current edition of the CMP rules. All competitors will comply with CMP eligibility requirements including the requirement to provide a notarized **CMP Eligibility Affidavit and Liability Agreement** (*Note: These agreements are required by federal law. Any competitor who competed in the National Matches, purchased a government-surplus rifle from the CMP or who provides evidence of having previously signed an eligibility agreement does not have to provide another agreement.*). The CMP will confirm eligibility to compete in the EIC match (*Distinguished status, number of EIC matches fired, etc.*) electronically when scorecards are entered in the CMP competitor record system.

The match will take place after the .45 individual match of the Regional.

There will be 25 shooting points available. A second relay will be shot if necessary.

The entry fee will be \$15.

**In order to ensure the successful conduct of this EIC Match the CMP will:**

1. Furnish official CMP EIC match scorecards that must be completed by all competitors, regardless of whether they complete the entire course of fire and that must be returned to the CMP within five days after the match.
2. Post date and contact information about this EIC match in the CMP Competition Tracker web site's "Upcoming Events" list (<http://clubs.odcmp.com/cgi-bin/index.cgi>).
3. Post an electronic final results list for this match on the CMP Competition Tracker web site's "Competition Results" list (<http://clubs.odcmp.com/cgi-bin/index.cgi>).
4. Award Excellence-In-Competition credit points and badges to competitors who qualify.
5. Award Place Medals to the 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3<sup>rd</sup> place competitors (Distinguished competitors are eligible for place medals).

**Distinguished Revolver Match  
River Bend Gun Club  
March 27,2010**

**MATCH IS TO BE FIRED IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE FOLLOWING RULES:**

**Eligibility:** Only individuals who are eligible for NRA Pistol Competition pursuant to Section 2 of the NRA Pistol Rules shall be eligible to compete in this program.

**Awards:** The NRA Distinguished Revolver Badge will be awarded to those competitors who earn a total of 30 points through unassisted individual competition in NRA Distinguished Revolver Matches. Credit points will be awarded to the highest scoring 10 percent of all non-Distinguished Revolver competitors firing in the match ranked in order of merit.

Fractions of .5 and over will be resolved to the next whole number. Smaller fractions will not be considered. The winning 10 per cent as described above will be further broken down and credit points awarded as follows:  
To the highest scoring 1/6th of the 10% qualifying . . . . . 10 Points  
. . . . . 10 Points  
To the next highest scoring 1/3 rd of the 10% qualifying . . . . . 8 Points  
. . . . . 8 Points  
To the remaining competitors authorized credit points . . . . . 6 Points  
. . . . . 6 Points

**Course of Fire:** The NRA National Match Course will be used for all competitions under this program. Tournaments wishing to host competitions under this program are limited to National Championships, Regional Championships, and State Championships as defined in Rule 1.6 which are conducted outdoors. Where a tournament is conducted in a single day, multiple relays of this match may be conducted throughout the day. Where a tournament is conducted across two or more days, multiple relays of this match may be conducted across multiple days and throughout each day.

**Rule 3.1.4 Distinguished Revolver:** The revolver must be capable of chambering and firing a 158-grain round nose or semi-wadcutter .38 Special cartridge. It must be a factory manufactured revolver with no external modifications except for stocks which may be modified or changed because of the size of the competitor's hand or to facilitate loading. Except for stocks and the honing of the sear or sear notch to make a more crisp trigger, and maintain a 2 ½ lb. minimum trigger pull, no external or internal modification may be made to the revolver as manufactured and sold by the factory of origin. No parts may be removed from the revolver, either externally or internally, nor may any part be added. Specifically prohibited is any system of recoil control based upon compensators, barrel venting, barrel porting or weighed grips.

**(a) Trigger** - Must have single and double action capability and must be capable of lifting 2 ½ lbs. when the revolver is cocked for single action firing. Triggers will be weighed. Any trigger, sold by the manufacturer of the revolver, without modification, may be used.

**(b) Sights** - Fixed or adjustable rear sights may be used. An adjustable front sight is not allowed.

**(c) Barrel** - Barrel length not to exceed six and one-half inches.

**(d) Stocks** - Except as set forth above, the right and left stocks must be mirror images of each other.

**(e) Ammunition** - New, factory manufactured ammunition or commercially re-manufactured ammunition: .38 Special

158 grain round nose lead bullet or .38 Special 158 grain lead semi-wadcutter only.

**(f) The following are not allowed:** Trigger shoes, compensators of any type or design; any external trigger stop

device or any internal trigger stop not originally installed by the factory as original equipment in stock revolvers of

the same make and model; tape on the stocks, stocks flared at the base or any substance which results in a sticky

surface to the stock or hand.
