

**Pinetuckey Gun Club**  
**2011 NRA Approved**  
**2700 Conventional Outdoor Pistol Match**

1. **2011 Match Dates:** Pinetuckey shoots the **1<sup>th</sup> Saturday of the month** as follows: February 5 (Not NRA Approved), March 5, April 2, May 7, June 4, July 2, August 6, September 3, October 1, and November 5. We will not shoot in December or January.

3. **Directions:** GPS: 2096 Greenland Rd, Blythe, GA 30805  
From I-20, take Bobby Jones Expressway ( I-520 ) East to Deans Bridge Road ( Hwy. 1 ), Exit onto Deans Bridge Road ( Hwy. 1 ) South toward Wrens. You will stay on Hwy 1 for eight (8) miles, at the top of the hill you will turn left onto Camp Josey Road and follow it to the end. Pinetucky has a sign on the left at Camp Josey Road and the Richmond County Sheriffs Department Training Range has a sign on the right, across from Camp Josey Road.
4. **Open to the Public:** NRA membership is not required; however, scores will not be reported to the NRA unless you have a membership and ID number is recorded on the SR-1.
5. **Entry fees:** \$20.00 for the 2700  
                  \$10.00 for each 900  
                  \$10.00 for the 2700 A new shooter may shoot .22 caliber for the 2700. Pinetuckey members receive a \$5.00 discount.
6. **Registration:** Registration starts at 8:30 AM. After the Center Fire match, there will be a one hour break. The .45 match will start when lunch is finished.
7. **Advanced Entries:** Entries can be sent in advance to Pinetuckey Gun Club, PO Box 211996, Martinez, GA 30917. NRA SR-1 card must be enclosed with advanced entries. Make checks payable to: Pinetuckey Gun Club
8. **Firing Time:** 9:15 AM
9. **Rules:** NRA Outdoor Conventional Pistol rules will be the governing rules for the match.
10. **Targets, Scoring, and Challenges:** Competitors will hang their own targets (50 yard B-6 and 25 yard B-8), score and replace. All strings of fire will be scored after 10 shots. Use of overlays is permitted. Use of plug type scoring gages will be restricted to range personnel. The fee will be \$1.00 per challenge, returnable if upheld.
